Focus: an improved mango variety

- The Ripple Africa team have used a technique known as grafting to develop an improved mango variety
- Grafting physically joins two plant varieties into one
- The improved mango provides several benefits, including growing quicker (providing fruit in as little as 3 years) and being tastier (much less stringy/fibrous and tough to eat) than the traditional local variety
