## Planting Fruit Trees campaign Jul - Sep 2022





## Campaign summary

- Location: Malawi, Africa
- Type of trees: we are focusing mainly on Guava and Papaya fruit trees, as well as trees for firewood like Senna Siamea, Pine and Blue Gum
- Who benefits: poor Malawian families benefit from the trees both for income generation and to provide both fruit and firewood for their own consumption
- Working with: our friends at Ripple Africa



## Case study: Masimu Primary School

- With such a young population (over 50% of the population is under 18), it is important to educate children about the merits of tree planting and conservation
- School committee members and students met the Ripple Africa team to learn about how to plant out the seedlings and care for the trees as they grow
- Papaya trees are fast growing and can start producing fruit from years 2 or 3. The school can both consume the fruit or sell it – providing children a valuable lesson in entrepreneurship
