- Location: Malawi, Africa

- Who benefits: poor Malawian families benefit from the trees both for income generation and to provide both fruit and firewood for their own consumption
- Working with: our friends at Ripple Africa

- At this time of the year, young trees are planted out from the tree nurseries, coinciding with the start of the rainy season which runs from now until April
- Selling fruit is a good income generator that can support the livelihood of people in the community. It can also empower women by providing them with the self-reliance associated with running an agri-business
